




Background

- SALL has been providing Baseball, Softball and Tee Ball programs to youth of Shippensburg and parts of Chambersburg since 1958
- On February 24 2019, strong winds brought a field light pole down at Doc Norcross Stadium
- Loss of this light rendered the entire field lighting system non-compliant with 2017 Little League Lighting Standards and Safety Audit
- SALL must replace the entire lighting system at an estimate of approximately \$145,000
- This cost was unforeseen and a substantial undertaking for a nonprofit organization, but is a critical investment in the league's growth
- SALL has engaged in a campaign to fundraise a majority of the total cost and has secured lending options for the remaining balance

Impact

- Safety: Remaining poles are in poor condition and must be removed for the safety of players/fans. New LED lights will provide better field lighting, allowing for safer night play
- Energy: Replacement of lights with LED lights will reduce the leagues energy footprint and will provide a long term cost savings on this investment
- Expansion: The ability to play night games allows the league to accommodate continuous growth
- Revenue: Inability to host double headers causes the league to lose substantial revenue during regular and All Star Tournament season as a host field
- Tradition: Playing under the lights has been a time honored tradition since the mid 1980's at Doc Norcross. Losing this capability takes away from our player experience






How You Can Help
